LEAD BY THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FACET, THE CHAPTER IDENTIFIED OPPORTUNITIES TO SUPPORT THE LINKING TOGETHER AGAINST SYNDROME X PROGRAM TO ADDRESS EDUCATION, AWARENESS AND PREVENTION.

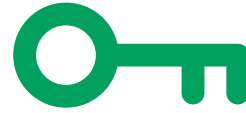
